Latin American Studies Program, Cornell, Ithaca, NY — LASP

As Program Manager for Cornell University's Latin American Studies Program (LASP), I directed all administrative, financial, marketing, and personnel operations to ensure efficient daily functioning and fiscal accountability. I managed events and film screenings, serving as co-publicist and press liaison, creating promotional materials, and coordinating logistics for visiting speakers and filmmakers. Collaborating with university departments and community partners, I worked to expand audience engagement and program visibility. I oversaw complex budgets, monitored income and expenditures, prepared monthly financial reports, and led the program's transition from WebFinancials to Kuali in coordination with Cornell's UBSC. Additionally, I supervised student employees, facilitated quarterly team meetings to enhance communication and development, and produced monthly reports evaluating activities, outcomes, and special project expenditures.

South Bronx Academy for Applied Media (MS296) New York, NY - ENL and Italian Teacher, Special Projects Coordinator, LEAP Arts Liaison,

August 2006 - June 2009

Developed MS296's first ELL and Italian program. Wrote and received a grant for \$65,000 for materials for the ELL program. Researched and ordered materials for the ELL grant and implemented their use. Created a pacing calendar and produced a presentation for the New York City Board of Education to demonstrate the successful implementation of grant materials. Analyzed the school's needs and collaborated with outside resources (LeAP Arts, Children for Children, Project BOOST) to provide the school with art, music, service learning, and cultural programs to meet those needs. Coordinated events such as professional development sessions, visiting teacher schedules, award ceremonies, fundraisers, and assemblies. Created an innovative hands-on field trip curriculum through Project BOOST funding (the International Culture Club). Established, coordinated, and advised the school's first National Junior Honor Society chapter to promote academics within the school. Collaborated with non-profit organizations to develop funding opportunities and supplied feedback to supporting organizations for the implementation of funding and results.
